5.2.2.1: Number of students qualifying in state/ national/ international level examinations (eg: JAM/CLAT/NET/ SLET/ GATE/ GMAT/CAT/GRE/ TOEFL/ Civil Services/ Judicial Services/Public Prosecution services/All India Bar Exams/State government examinations) year wise during last five years

In the last five years (2018-2022), a total of 220 students graduated with the Bachelors of Pharmacy degree from the Govt. College of Pharmacy, Rohru. Percentage of students qualifying in state/national/ international level examinations during the last five years was **32.77%** (National and State Level).

For the students with bachelor's degree in pharmacy, major national level examination is Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT), National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPER) Joint Entrance Exam, and Common Management Admission Test (CMAT). For the students with bachelor's degree in pharmacy, major state level exams include examination conducted by Himachal Pradesh Govt. for the recruitment of Pharmacists and Drugs Inspectors.

During last 5-years, 172 students appeared for various state and national level examinations. Out of these, a total of 56 students qualified Graduate Aptitude Pharmacy Test (GPAT) conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA), 16 students qualified state level examinations for Pharmacist, Drugs inspector, Lab technician, etc., 12 students successfully qualified National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPER) examination, and a total of 8 students qualified exams such as GATE/ CMAT, etc. Percentage of students qualifying in state/national/ international level examinations with respect to number of appeared students during the last five years = **41.86%**

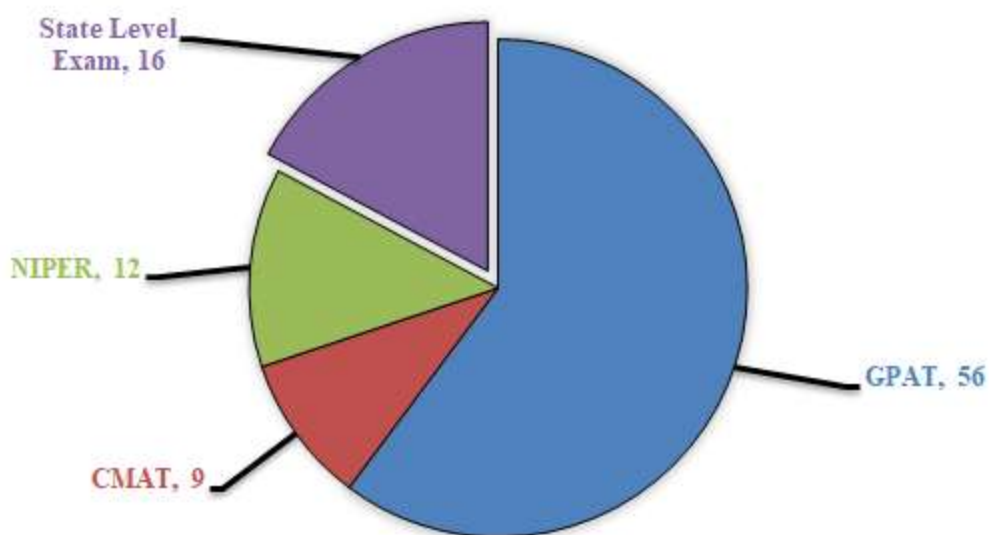

5.2.2.2: Number of students appearing in state/ national/ international level examinations (eg: JAM/CLAT/NET/ SLET/ GATE/ GMAT/CAT, GRE/ TOFEL/ Civil Services/ State government examinations) year wise during last five years.

In the last five years (2018-2022), a total of 220 students graduated with the Bachelors of Pharmacy degree from the Govt. College of Pharmacy, Rohru. It is evident that not all the students are willing to opt for higher education or govt. jobs, and therefore are not willing to appear for the various examinations for higher education and Govt. jobs. Such students either prefer to join private sector/ industry or start their own business (medical store/ wholesale store, which is an excellent opportunity for pharmacy graduates).

In the academic year 2017-2018, a total of **31 students** appeared for national and state level examination. 34 students appeared for GPAT, 10 students appeared for CMAT, and 01 appeared for State Govt. exam.


In the academic year 2018-2019, a total of **43 students** appeared for national and state level examination. 28 students appeared for GPAT, and 21 appeared for State Govt. exam.

In the academic year 2019-2020, a total of **36 students** appeared for national and state level examination. 24 students appeared for GPAT, and 14 appeared for State Govt. exam.

In the academic year 2020-2021, a total of **29 students** appeared for national and state level examination. 29 students appeared for GPAT, 01 students appeared for CMAT, and 10 students appeared for NIPER.

In the academic year 2021-2022, a total of **33 students** appeared for national and state level examination. 27 students appeared for GPAT, 01 students appeared for CMAT, 09 students appeared for NIPER, and 06 students appeared for State Govt. exam.

Percentage of students qualifying in state/national/ international level examinations (out of entire 220 graduated students) during the last five years was **32.27%** (National and State Level). However, if we consider this with respect to the number of students who actually appeared for such examinations (172 students), the percentage of qualification reach up to **41.86%**.



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

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT ARE AS UNDER:-
