7.2.1 Describe two best practices successfully implemented by the Institution as per NAAC format provided in the Manual.

<u>Best Practice 1:</u> <u>Promoting Holistic Student Development Through Extracurricular</u> <u>Activities</u>

<u>1. Title of the Practice:</u>

Fostering Skill Development and National Representation Through NSS and Spoken Tutorial Program.

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- To provide students with opportunities for skill enhancement and self-learning through the Spoken Tutorial program.
- To encourage participation in national-level events and promote leadership, cultural awareness, and social service through NSS.
- To ensure that students are well-rounded individuals with a combination of technical, leadership, and cultural skills.

3. The Context:

The institution aims to cultivate a comprehensive learning environment that extends beyond academics, focusing on student involvement in both skill development and extracurricular activities. Recognizing the importance of holistic growth, the institution integrated the **Spoken Tutorial program** to impart technical skills and the **NSS** (**National Service Scheme**) for leadership and cultural participation. This combination helps students excel both academically and personally, enhancing their employability and contributing to their overall development.









4. The Practice:

The institution has successfully implemented two complementary practices for student development:

- **Spoken Tutorial Program:** This initiative allows students to learn Free and Open Source Software through self-paced, multi-lingual tutorials. Over 249 students from GCP Rohru completed the training, acquiring proficiency in various software tools that enhance their technical capabilities.
- NSS Participation in National Events: The institution actively encourages students to participate in national events through NSS. For example, Rishabh, an NSS volunteer from GCP Rohru, represented Himachal Pradesh at the **27th National Youth Festival** held in Nashik, Maharashtra. This participation helped the student develop leadership skills, cultural appreciation, and national pride, all while contributing to the success of the event.

5. Evidence of Success:

- 249 students successfully completed the Spoken Tutorial training, gaining valuable digital skills.
- Rishabh's participation in the **National Youth Festival** was a proud representation of the institution and state, fostering a sense of national unity and cultural diversity.
- The integration of these activities has led to increased student engagement in both technical learning and extracurricular pursuits.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

Challenges included initial hesitation from some students in adopting self-paced learning through Spoken Tutorials and the rigorous selection process for national events. However, faculty support and institutional resources, including access to computers and internet, helped overcome









these barriers. Travel and accommodation for NSS events required logistical planning and coordination.

7. Impact:

This combined practice has contributed significantly to the development of well-rounded students at GCP Rohru. By participating in both technical skill-building programs like Spoken Tutorials and national-level events through NSS, students have become more competent, confident, and socially responsible, ready to face challenges in both professional and personal spheres.

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






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
